KINGS BAY PLOWSHARES 7

"They face 25 years in prison for exposing illegal and immoral nuclear weapons that threaten all life on Earth"

Kings Bay Trident Submarine Base in Georgia is home to six US Trident submarines and periodically services Britain's four Vanguard-class Trident submarines.

On the night of 4 April 2018 seven Catholic peace activists — Mark Colville, Clare Grady, Martha Hennessy, Father Steven Kelly, Liz McAlister, Patrick O'Neill and Carmen Trotta, now known as The Kings Bay Plowshares 7 — entered the base to draw attention to the crime of nuclear weapons. They used bolt cutters to remove the padlocks at the entrance and cut through a razor-wire fence. They spray-painted messages ("Love One Another"), hung banners ("The Ultimate Logic of TRIDENT — OMNICIDE: Plowshares Now"), removed lighted signs, poured blood (their own blood, which they carried in bottles) on military emblems and the ground, and hammered on base property. After approximately two hours in the base they were arrested and taken to prison to await trial.

The trial took place 18 months later: the week starting 21 October 2019. After four days they were all found guilty on all counts – conspiracy, trespass, and destruction and depredation of government property. The judge said she would take between sixty and ninety days to decide on their sentences. Each of the 7 could face a term of 25 years in jail.

In the trial Clare Grady told the court "We believe that Trident is the biggest crime we know of. It is like a cocked gun pointing at the head of the planet."

"While awaiting the verdict defence lawyer, Bill Quigley, [who represented Ms McAlister], said the defendants wanted the chance to appear in court and have a discussion about the horror of nuclear weapons and why they went to the base to protest against them.

He said his only regret was that, due to restrictions ordered by the judge before the trial, they had been unable to talk more about the Trident missiles and their terrible destructive power." (Linda Pentz Gunter, Morning Star, October 26-27 2019)

"The activists said they were following the prophet Isaiah's command to beat swords into plowshares. They were barred from citing their religious motivation or from mounting a "necessity defense" saying that their law breaking was necessary to prevent the far greater crime of nuclear war." (democracynow.org; Kings Bay Plowshares 7)

Bill Quigley said the jury was not allowed to hear that the submarines in Kings Bay have 3,800 times as much destructive power as the weapon that was used on Hiroshima, enough power to destroy life on Earth as we know it.
